










Finding Your Grade

Here are some easy steps to find your grade for classes.

1. Go to the MY HOMEROOM tab in Blackboard.
2. On the left hand side, click on View Grades in the Tools Menu
3. Click on whichever class you want to view grades for. (Guidance classes do not have grades)
4. You can print any of these sheets so you can view them that way as well.
5. If you see a **—** that means that NO assignment has been turned in for that assignment, and it is still open. You can then go in and complete that assignment.
6. If you see a **0** that means that no assignment was turned in and the teacher has closed this assignment, because it was after the due date. If the student wishes to do this assignment or if they have it done and did not turn it in, simply email the teacher and he/she will re-open it for them. (**You can only re-do assignments that you can currently see in your ASSIGNMENTS tab in the class)
7. If you see a  this means that you have turned the assignment in and it is waiting to be graded by the teacher.
8. If you see a  the student was exempt or excused from that assignment is not required to complete it.
9. If you see a **NUMBERED GRADE**, this is what you earned on this assignment. Any comments that the teacher may have regarding this assignment will be listed beside this.
10. For graded assignments, you can also **CLICK** on the grade and you will get another box that will show what you have turned in.
11. Below is the ICON LEGEND for the grade book.
